### **6-If Conditional**

### It is of three kinds:

6-1-First conditional:It expresses a possible condition and its probable result in the future (real situation).

#### Pattern:

-If+present simple tense+future(shall or will)

### Example:

If I find your bag,I shall give it to you(reality).

6-2-Second conditional :It expresses unreal situation and its result (improbable, imaginary and unreal situations).

#### Pattern:

-If+Past simple tense+future (should or would)

### Example:

-If I won some money, I should go around the world.

6-3-Third condition: It expresses something that will never happen(impossible situation).

#### Pattern:

If+ past perfect tense+ would or should+have+P.P.

## Example:

-If I had seen a ghost, I should have taken picture of him.

### **Zero Conditional**

**Zero conditional** sentences refer to all time ,not just the present or future. They express a situation that is always true. If means when or whenever.

# Example:

-If I spend over 50\$ at that supermarket, you get a five per cent discount.
