Simple Future Tense

It refers to an action that happen in future.

Pattern:

 $S+Will\{he,she,it,you\}$ or $shall\{I,we\}+infinitive(verb without to)+Adv(next, in the future,tomorrow).$

Example:

She will go to the college tomorrow.

There are three forms that can refer to the future.

1-S+will or shall+ infinitive.

Examples:

- (a)I shall see you later.
- (b)I do not think Layla will do very well in her exam(she does not do any work).

The future forms (will or shall) express prediction depending on opinion.

2-S+Aux+going to+Com

Examples:

(a)I am going to see a film tonight(do you want to come?) (going to).
